Dear Mission Friend!

We are leaving behind an exciting half-year of work and are confidently looking forward to what God will do for the rest of the year.

In mid-April, we started an online course for leaders in South Asia. About thirty leaders have enrolled and are working through the first module of the course. We have a particularly large group from Pakistan, which is especially exciting as we have just completed the translation into the local language, Urdu. The others are from India, Sri Lanka, Cambodia, Thailand, and Indonesia. The goal of the course is to open new frontiers for FBS in these respective countries.

## **Mozambique**

Recently, I received a very encouraging message from Mozambique about a pastor who shared that FBS has completely transformed his life and his congregation. He incorporates parts of the teaching into almost every sermon, and since he began doing so, no one in his congregation goes hungry anymore. They have also managed to build a new church, and when they dedicated it, the entire church was paid for.



## **Kenya**

Mikael Nimmersjö was in Kenya last year conducting a teacher training, and now they have started a class outside Nairobi with 16 students. It's a modest beginning.

## **Jordan**

Next month, I will be traveling to Jordan to train Christian leaders from Bethlehem Bible College in the FBS material. We will also have our friends from Egypt with us to help with the training.

We are part of a larger project aimed at creating jobs and businesses among Christian Arabs in Judea, Samaria, and Gaza. European financiers and entrepreneurs are involved in the

project. There is an urgent need to assist Christian entrepreneurs and those needing work in these areas, especially given the ongoing war, which is a significant strain on the local population.

- God's guidance for the fall of 2024 with many new and interesting places to work with.
- Openings in Asia so we can establish ourselves in all countries in South Asia.
